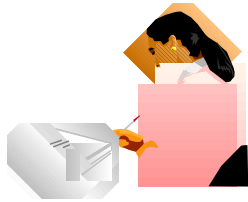

TIPS FOR JOB SEEKERS

- ❖ Bring at least 15 copies of your resume (proofread your resume) & 4 black/blue ink pens
- ❖ Dress professionally (suits are always a plus!); stay organized- bring a folder to keep materials organized
- ❖ Take time to talk to employers; offer a firm handshake and maintain eye contact
- ❖ Develop some questions you'd like to ask employers; don't expect to be offered a job at the event
- ❖ Don't be afraid of the recruiters- approach them with confidence
- ❖ Don't just drop your resume and walk away, take time to market yourself
- ❖ Don't interrupt, patiently wait your turn; don't monopolize the employer
- ❖ Don't lie about your abilities and skills
- ❖ Follow-up with a thank you note
